The objective of **SAMADHAN** was to discover and nurture impactful technology-enabled innovations to become full-fledged commercially viable and market-ready products that can help fight against challenges posed by COVID-19. Under dire situations like these, the innovations should be rolled out in the reliable in

market as soon as possible, so the nature of these innovations should be of low cost, easily accessible to the largest section of the target beneficiaries, reliable in quality, and can be adopted & used without specialized skills or additional resources. In order to ensure that only the best innovations reach the market, a jury panel with experts from different organizations was formed to assess and judge the innovations with their domain expertise.

Apart from this, through the "SAMADHAN" challenge, work was taken up to make citizens aware, motivate and face challenges to prevent any crisis and to help people get livelihood.







MENTORS


