INTRODUCTION

Globally, 35.4% of people with diabetes mellitus were estimated to have diabetic retinopathy in 2012 and 11.7% had sight-threatening disease.

In 2017, 73 of the 451 million people with diabetes worldwide (16.2%) lived in India.

Studies carried out in the country over the last decade reported that diabetic retinopathy prevalence were approximately 9.6% in rural areas and 18.0% (255/1414) in urban areas; the rates of sight-threatening retinopathy in the two areas were 3.8% (45/1190) and 6.6% (39/592), respectively.

Risk factors for diabetic retinopathy include longer duration of diabetes, poor diabetes control and hypertension. Evidence from high-income countries indicates that the risk of visual loss from diabetic retinopathy can be reduced by strategies such as better control of blood glucose and hypertension and regular screening to detect individuals with sight-threatening diabetic retinopathy, followed by confirmatory diagnosis and appropriate management.

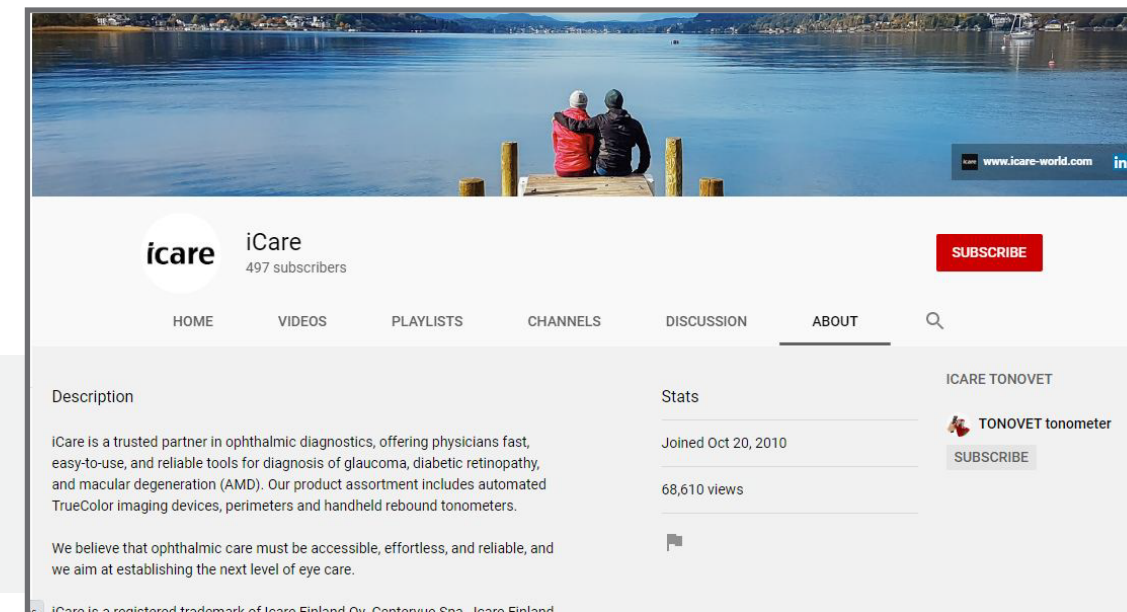

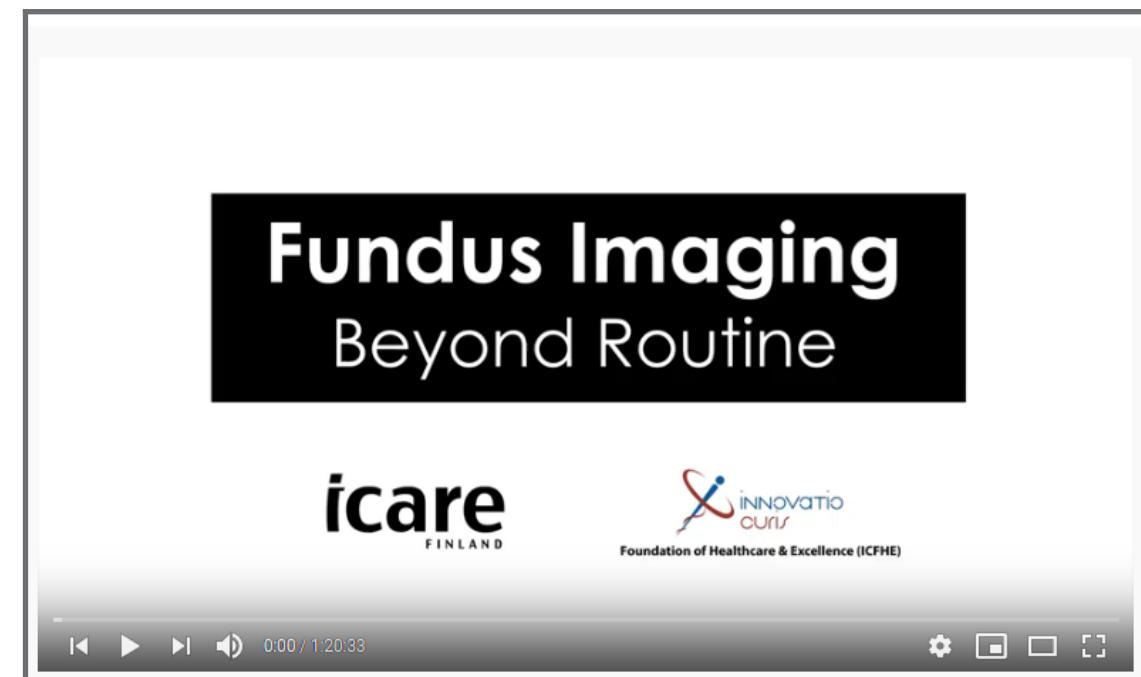
